Mr. Suresh was born on 22nd November, 1991 in Nava Bharath, Palavantha. He was one of two children in the family, he and his elder sister. His father passed away when he was studying in the 7th Std and his mother single handedly managed to bring them up and give them good Education. Soon after his MBA, he joined us in the month of November, 2015 as the Business Manager of the Economic Justice project here in Mulakalapalli.

Mr. Suresh was a zealous social worker. He was the very essence of compassion, duty, and commitment. He was very humane, a standard-bearer for the rights of the downtrodden. His six years of service in Mulakalapalli stole many hearts. He was admired for his systematic planning, manner of conducting activities in the project, responsible dealing with the poor and the needy, net working with like-minded NGOs, GOs, friendly rapport with colleagues, team work and brotherly affection with sisters. He was very spontaneous, humorous, simple in lifestyle but great in his contribution. He worked hard, regardless of name and fame to uplift and empower the target group - tribal men and women, along with sisters and staff. He brought awareness to hundreds of women about various bank schemes and helped them to have their own savings in the cooperative society. In a short period of time he achieved many things for the welfare of the people and dreamt of brightening their future, but unfortunately he has gone to God before he could accomplish his dream. He was very innovative and creative. He took a lot of initiative and interest to make known our mission and published our local activities in the social media regularly.

Mr. Suresh was an active and passionate Mission partner and was very much inspired by the spirit of our Mother Foundress, St. Mary Euphrasia. This led him to upload her quotes on the social media, for such was his zeal. He was also moved by our Charism of merciful, compassionate love for the needy. He had a high regard for all the Good Shepherd Sisters.
